

How We Serve Our Community:



Flagship Programs

Club Latinitas- After-school programs focused on technology, digital media, culture and identity.

Chica Conferences- One day events where technology and media are used as tools for career exploration.

Code Chica- program where teen girls build a website using HTML/CSS or Javascript.




